 three 3-subject spiral notebooks—college ruled (Meade 5 Star Brand with a plastic cover works best as you MUST be able to glue an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper flat on the page without it hanging over the edge OR without cutting it. We will use these as Interactive Notebooks.)

 one 2" three-ring binder (D ring style)

 1 pencil pouch with holes to fit in binder. Should include the following:

 #2 pencils

 checking pens (color of your choosing—red, purple, green)

 pair scissors

 yellow highlighters

 erasers (cap or handheld)

 black Sharpie markers

 rolls Scotch (clear) tape

 colored pencils—Crayola or Rose Art

 washable markers—Crayola or Rose Art (most students prefer the fat tip markers)

 2 packs loose leaf notebook paper (wide-ruled; to be collected by the teacher)

 4 marble composition books (wide-ruled) *Different colored covers will help students stay organized.

 6 fat glue sticks—Elmer's or Rose Art

 Seat Sack **Students will be switching classes and must have a bag to carry their items.


