

# Three Chopt 4<sup>th</sup> GradeZone Center Supply List

\_\_\_ **three 3-subject spiral notebooks—college ruled** (Meade 5 Star Brand with a plastic cover works best as you MUST be able to glue an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper flat on the page without it hanging over the edge OR without cutting it. We will use these as Interactive Notebooks.)

\_\_\_ **one 2” three-ring binder** (D ring style)

\_\_\_ **1 pencil pouch with holes to fit in binder.** *Should include the following:*

\_\_\_ **#2 pencils**

\_\_\_ **checking pens (color of your choosing-red, purple, green)**

\_\_\_ **pair scissors**

\_\_\_ **yellow highlighters**

\_\_\_ **erasers (cap or handheld)**

\_\_\_ **black Sharpie markers**

\_\_\_ **rolls Scotch (clear) tape**

\_\_\_ **colored pencils—Crayola or Rose Art**

\_\_\_ **washable markers—Crayola or Rose Art** (most students prefer the fat tip markers)

\_\_\_ **2 packs loose leaf notebook paper** (wide-ruled; to be collected by the teacher)

\_\_\_ **4 marble composition books** (wide-ruled) \*Different colored covers will help students stay organized.

\_\_\_ **6 fat glue sticks—Elmer’s or Rose Art**

\_\_\_ **1 pack graph paper**

\_\_\_ **Post-it notes**

\_\_\_ **4 durable pocket folders** (with holes to put in the binder)

\_\_\_ **2 packs 3x5 lined note cards**

\_\_\_ **1 12-inch ruler**

\_\_\_ **small dictionary for desk** (for example Merriam Webster or miniature OED)
